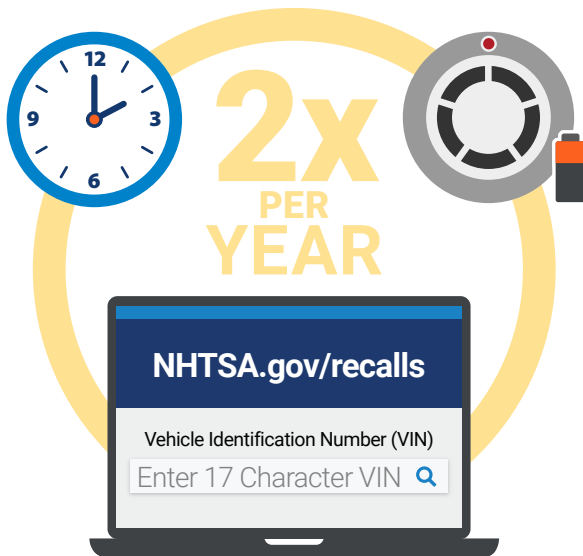

## CHECKING FOR SAFETY RECALLS IS FREE AND EASY!

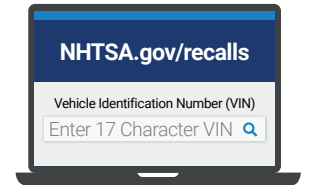
### Locate your VIN

Check the lower left of your car's windshield for your 17-character Vehicle Identification Number (VIN).



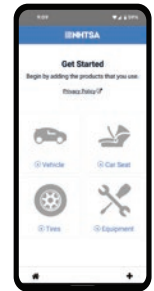
### Visit NHTSA.gov/recalls

Enter your VIN. NHTSA will provide details on any unrepaired recalls for your vehicle.



### Download the SaferCar App

Enter your VIN and add car seats, tires, or other vehicle-related equipment. NHTSA will send you an alert if a safety recall is issued.



*All safety recalls are important and should be repaired immediately!*
